4-H Insurance Due April 17th All 4-H members are required to have 4-H in-

surance. American Income Life Insurance Company (AIL) provides the following insurance policies for South Dakota. Below is the cost:

- " If the 4-H member is in non-horse projects the cost is \$1.50.
- " Cloverbud insurance is \$1.50.
- " If the 4-H member is in horse project the cost is \$2.50.
- " If the 4-Her is in rodeo, insurance cost is \$40 unless the family has its own insurance to cover rodeo, then they must purchase the \$2.50 horse insurance.

SDSU Livestock Judging Camp

Camp 1: June 7-9 Camp 2: June 11-13

The SDSU Livestock Judging Camp is open to all youth ages 11-18. Included in these camps:

- 1-on-1 reasons coaching from SDSU's nationally competitive team
- Instruction form SDSU Livestock Judging Coach
 Tommy Norman
- Judge multiple live classes of cattle, sheep, goats and swine
- Experience SDSU's state-of-the-art livestock units
- Explore the SDSU campus and stay in the residence halls
- Connect with current SDSU students and members of the collegiate judging team

Cost is \$250 and includes two-nights lodging in SDSU residence halls, six meals plus refreshments, recreational activities, judging manual and a camp T-shirt. Must be 11 years old by January 1, 2023 to register.

Camp registration will be opening soon, follow the SDSU Livestock Judging Team Facebook page for updates. **Registration closes May 19th**-a \$50 late fee will be applied to registrations submitted after May 19th.

Poultry Update

Though incidence may taper somewhat from last year, it is expected that Avian Bird Flu will remain active in South Dakota during the 2023 migration seasons. What does this mean in relation to live poultry shows during the upcoming fair exhibition season? Right now, there are no regulations for South Dakota, but the Animal Industry Board (AIB) will continue to watch for updates. Poultry Pullorum Free Proof

Poultry purchased from your local farm store or hatchery must come from a certified Pullorum-Typhoid free source, or have been tested to prove that they are Pullorum-Typhoid free. Make sure you request a certificate proving that they are disease free and keep for your records. If you do not have the paperwork that your poultry is disease free, they will need to be tested by a certified tester.

Animal Input in 4HOnline



4HOnline is open for animal entry. The deadline for entering animals (excluding Companion Animal) into 4HOnline is **June 1st at 11:59 pm CST**. Companion Animal must be entered into 4HOnline before they register for State Fair.

DNA Collection Envelopes

All market animals in Market Beef, Market Goat, Market Sheep and Market Swine intended for 4-H competition

at the South Dakota State Fair are required to submit DNA samples. A DNA sample must be self-identified and submitted to the County 4-H Office **by June 1, 2023** for State Fair eligibility.

DNA envelopes are available at the 4-H Office. It is the 4-H families responsibility to collect DNA samples and put in the envelope, complete the information on the envelope and any signatures that are required.

Market Animals **without** a DNA sample on file by the June 1 deadline will be ineligible for competition at the South Dakota State Fair, regardless of the participating status in the County 4-H Achievement Days/County Fair.

State 4-H Horse Show Update

Due to the construction occurring at the South Dakota State Fairgrounds, the 2023 State 4-H Horse Show will be held at the Stanley County Fairgrounds July 24-26, 2023 in Fort Pierre, SD. The contestant packet and the 2023 Horse Project Guide will be available mid-April.

Youth Livestock Literacy (YLL)

There will be a Youth Livestock Literacy Training TBA when the Livestock Committee decides on a date, time and topics. Be looking for updates in upcoming 4-H newsletters.

You can also get YLL certification by taking the YQCA online web-training (cost \$12) as your YLL event. The link is: <u>https://yqcaprogram.org/</u>

The training and YQCA certification need to be completed by **July 1, 2023**. If you take the YQCA training, when registering be sure you put the 4-Her's name, not the parent's name in when registering. When complete, print your certificate, scan and email to the 4-H Office. Then I will put the completion date into 4HOnline.
