Dog Program Clinic June 11 in Huron

The Dog Program Education Team will host a 4-H Dog Program Clinic for beginning and experienced members across the state. Details and registration link can be found at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/ZLWB769>.

Saturday, June 11, 10 am to 3 pm: Family Living Center, State Fair Grounds, Huron, SD

The clinic will focus on the basics of preparing your dog to compete in the 4-H Dog Program including grooming, dog games, how to practice, dog safety and how to enroll your dog. All experience levels are encouraged to attend.

Bring the following: current vaccination record, dog crate (with a blanket or cover), dog bowl, water from home, dog food, favorite toy, leash, waste bags, variety of high value treats, lawn chairs and fan.

There will be a break for lunch, plan on bringing food or dining in Huron.

County 4-H Horse Show

County horse show information was sent to those individuals who have completed the horse safety training. The county horse show will be held Monday, **June 20, 2022** at the Stanley County Fairgrounds. **Deadline is June 6th to register.**

State 4-H Horse Show is scheduled for July 25-27, 2022 at the SD State Fairgrounds, Huron, SD.

Special Foods Contest

This event combines food preparation skill, nutrition knowledge and aesthetic awareness. The member plans and prepares a nutritious dish, an accompanying menu and table setting to enhance the dish. During the preparation the participant is given the opportunity to share their knowledge of the nutrient composition of the dish.

A Special Foods Contest has been scheduled for **Tuesday, June 21, 2022** at the United Methodist Church Trinity Community Center. There is a new Special Foods Handbook and forms, I will be emailing these items to those who have signed up for the contest.

Pre-registrations are due Monday, June 13th.

Breed Registration Papers

A copy of bred registration papers for registered and/or purebred animals must be uploaded in 4HOnline by **July 1 at 11:59 pm CT**. If a registration paper is not available by July 1, **an official letterhead with a detailed explanation from the breed association must be uploaded in its place**. Failure to upload a registration paper by July 1 will result in the animal being exhibited in the commercial/grade/crossbred division.

Exhibitors should have the original paper copy of the registration paper in hand during check in at State Fair.

Registration papers must show at least one of the following:

- 1) The member's name as owner
- 2) The name of the exhibitor and/or co-owner who is a member or the exhibitor's immediate family (parent or siblings/ members of household)
- 3) The family ranch or farm name or parent's name

YQCA Needs to be Done by July 1

Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) is required for all 4-H members exhibiting livestock (beef cattle, dairy cattle, dairy goats, meat goats, sheep, swine, poultry, and rabbits at county-level or State Fair are required to become YQCA certified.

The instructor-led training has been completed, for those of you who missed the training, you will need to take the web-based training which costs \$12. I have attached the help sheet to help you with the process.

YQCA certificates need to be uploaded into 4HOnline by **July 1st at 11:59 pm CT**. You only need to load the certificate to one animal. Also, please scan the certificate and send to the 4-H Office.

true 4-H'ers-desiring a fair exhibition experience and willing to demonstrate personal responsibility.

This pledge is a component of the annual Youth Livestock Literacy training requirement that will be implemented in 2023. The annual paper-based agreements must be completed by each 4-H member to be eligible to exhibit beef, swine, dairy, poultry, rabbits or goats at the local and/or state level. In addition, exhibitors competing at State Fair will complete an electronic acknowledgment annually during FairEntry enrollment.

Prior to agreeing, please read, consider, and fully adopt the Livestock Integrity Pledge's principles in your livestock management plan. Upon completion, please return the signed form to the 4-H Office, PO Box 970, Fort Pierre, SD or by emailing it to HughesStanley.County@sdstate.edu. Youth and parent/guardian must sign and date the pledge.

This form was sent to all 4-H members who have completed the YQCA training.

If youth and/or a parent/guardian refuse to complete the form, they are NOT allowed to compete in 4-H livestock exhibition.

South Dakota 4-H Livestock Integrity Pledges are due to the 4-H Office by July 1, 2022.

Public Presentation

Public presentations is a Youth-in-Action event that any 4-H member may participate in. The categories are demonstration, illustrated talk, project why, and public speaking. The criteria for each category is described on the Stanley County website, click on 4H/Extension, scroll down till you come to the Youth-in-Action area.

The public presentation contest is scheduled for **Tuesday, July 12, 2022** at the SDSU Pierre Regional Center. Time is to be determined. **Registration deadline is July 5, 2022.**

Fashion Revue

Fashion Revue is a 4-H Youth-in-Action event that promotes life skills such as clothing selection, fit, coordination, and construction. Each 4-Her constructs and/or selects his/her own garment in which to model in front of a panel of judges. Through participation in this event, 4-Hers have the opportunity to learn about wardrobe selection, accessorizing, poise, presence, and consumer purchasing/buying techniques.

The Fashion Revue Contest is scheduled for **Tuesday, July 19, 2022** at the Pat Duffy Community Center, Fort Pierre, SD. Time is to be determined.

Pre-registrations are due to the 4-H Office no later than Wednesday, July 13th.

Premier Exhibitor Awards at State Level

Premier Livestock Exhibitor Award:

Thanks to an inspired bill passed during the 2020 4-H Legislature event, South Dakota 4-H is re-launching the Premier Livestock Exhibitor Award beginning with the 2022 season. This award recognizes a more comprehensive development of livestock project knowledge in alignment with the 4-H Livestock Management Triangle.

During this initial year of the Premier Livestock Exhibitor Awards there are two categories and three age divisions (beginner, junior, senior) including: Large Animal (Beef, Swine, Sheep, Goat) and Small Animal (Dairy Cattle, Dairy Goat, Poultry, Rabbit).

These awards will be determined by the exhibitor's scores from State Fair Showmanship, State Skillathon Contest and State Fair Market/Breeding contest. The top five exhibitors in each category and division will be recognized at the State 4-H Livestock Judging/Skillathon Contest in September.

Premier Horse Exhibitor Award:

South Dakota 4-H will be launching the Premier Horse Exhibitor Awards beginning with the 2022 season. This award recognizes a more comprehensive development of horse project knowledge.

These awards will be determined by the exhibitor's scores from State Horse Show Showmanship, State Hippology Contest and the highest Event Score excluding showmanship. The top five exhibitors in each of the three 4-H age divisions (beginner, junior, senior) will be recognized at the State 4-H Horse Show in Huron, SD.

Premier Dog Exhibitor Award:

South Dakota 4-H will be launching the Premier Dog Exhibitor Awards beginning with the 2022 season. This award recognizes a more comprehensive development of dog project knowledge.

These awards will be determined by the exhibitor's State Dog Show scores in Showmanship, Skillathon and the highest Event Score excluding showmanship. The top five exhibitors in each of the three 4-H age divisions (beginner, junior, senior) will be recognized at the State 4-H Dog Show in Huron, SD.

Swine (Breeding & Market combined): 4 Entries
4-H Display Exhibits: 6 Entries
