2021 Teen Leadership Conference

The 2021 Teen Leadership Conference (TLC) will be held on the campus of Dakota State University in Madison, SD on **June 7-11, 2021**. All teens, ages 13-18 are invited to “Go for the Gold” at TLC. Registration will be \$325/teen delegate. Registration **is open** on the extension.sdstate.edu website and **will close May 9, 2021**. This is a change of venue from past years, but they are excited to offer new learning opportunities and experiences for the participants. Due to COVID-19 mitigation practices, no transportation will be provided from West River, therefore families should make travel plans accordingly.

2021 Prairie Winds 4-H Scholarship

The Prairie Winds 4-H Leader’s Council is pleased to announce the Fifth Annual Prairie Winds 4-H Scholarship. The scholarship is in the amount of \$500.

Please contact your school counselor or the 4-H Office for application and eligibility requirements. The application and supporting documents need to be received in the Prairie Winds 4-H Office no later than close of business **May 18, 2021**. No late applications will be accepted.

South Dakota 4-H Performing Arts Camp

The 2021 South Dakota 4-H Performing Arts Troupe Camp will take place June 6 – 12, 2021, at Northern State University in Aberdeen, SD. You who are 13, or have completed 7th grade, to age 18, as of January 1 during the current 4-H program year are eligible to participate in the Performing Arts Troupe. The camp prepares youth to perform during the week at the 2021 South Dakota State Fair in Huron, from September 4 - 6, 2021. To have the best performances, the two camp shows in Aberdeen and the five shows during the 2021 South Dakota State Fair should be attended by all troupe members. The committee must be made aware of any conflicts as soon as possible. The registration fee from April 15 – May 15 is \$375. The registration fee from May 16 – May 31 is \$400. Youth with a financial need are eligible for a \$25 discount at this event thanks to our partners at Tractor Supply Company. YQCA certification must be completed and uploaded to 4HOnline by **July 1, 2021**. Registration and payment for trainings will be done online.

I have attached the help sheet for families to register. At step 14, participants will search for the “Hughes/Stanley/Sully County 4-H YQCA Training; Pat Duffy Community Center” on June 3, 2021. **Participants must register by May 28th, 2021.**

If you are not able to make it to an in-person training, you can do the web-based training, contact the 4-H Office and I will send out the information on how to become certified through the web training.

Remember, you will need to take the certification in order to show livestock at the county and state level.

County 4-H Horse Show

County horse show information has been sent to those individuals who have completed the horse safety training. The county horse show will be held Wednesday, June 2, 2021 at the Stanley County Fairgrounds. **Deadline is May 26th to register.**

Horse Updates: Horse Youth in Action projects will continue to use previous material (not the 2021 updated versions) for the 2021 season.

An edited version of both the Horse Contestant Packet and Project Guide will be updated on the website soon.

Animal in 4-H Online

4-H Online is now open for families to input animal information. Families will have until **June 1st at 11:59 pm** to enter animals into 4-H Online, with the exception of Companion Animals. Companion Animals will have until August 10th at 11:59 pm to enter their animal information. The Help Sheet for families can be found at:

Remember your livestock and horse projects need to be enrolled into 4HOnline on by June 1st at 11:59 pm CT.

DNA Samples & NUES Tags

DNA collection is required for market animals (beef, sheep, goat and swine) that you want to show at the SD State Fair. If you are going to show them at county only, you do not need to complete DNA collection. DNA envelopes and NUES tags are available at the 4-H Office. The 4-H member/family is responsible for properly collecting the DNA sample and placing it in the envelope, recording the correct animal ID (Ear Tag/EID/Scrapies/Ear Notch No.), date, species, animal gender, and collecting all the signatures required on the envelope. The DNA Envelope is due to the 4-H Office no later than **June 1, 2021 by 3 pm**. Remember to enter all animals into 4HOnline by **June 1, 2021**. The cost of the DNA Sample is \$6/sample. If writing a check, please make it payable to Prairie Winds 4-H.

Special Foods Contest

A Special Foods Contest has been scheduled for **Tuesday, June 22, 2021** at the United Methodist Church Trinity Community Center. If you have not let the 4-H Office know that you are interested in doing Special Foods, please do so ASAP, (I have three registered right now). There is a new Special Foods Handbook and forms, I will be emailing these items to those who have signed up for the contest.

Fashion Revue/Public Presentations

A date has not been set at this time, but if you would like to participate in either event, please contact the 4-H Office ASAP, so we can start setting a date and finding a location to have these events.

4-H State Fair Update

4-H members are allowed to exhibit 12 Exhibits total between Animal Exhibits, Display Exhibits, and Youth-in-Action Events at the SD State Fair. 4-H members are allowed to exhibit up to **4 display exhibits, 4 exhibits per each animal species, and 4 exhibits per each Youth-in-Action Event.**

Prairie Winds 4-H Achievement Days

Scheduled for August 1-3, 2021 at the Stanley County Fairgrounds, Fort Pierre, SD. The 4-H Leaders' Council is planning the event as long as Covid-19 cases do not get extremely high, it could be a modified achievement days, only time will tell. So, mark your calendar!

Poultry Pullorum Free Documentation

If you are purchasing your poultry, be sure that it comes from a certified Pullorum-Typhoid free source or have a test done to verify that they are Pullorum-Typhoid free. If you purchase your poultry from a farm store or hatchery, request a certificate proving this and keep your receipt. If you don't have the paperwork verifying your poultry is Pullorum-Typhoid free, you will need to have them tested by a certified tester. A date will be set in the summer for those poultry that need to be tested.

4-H Project Training

There are two judges training session planned for mid-summer. The training will not be project specific, but will cover a more general overview. More information will be coming on registration and access. All will be held via Zoom conferencing and recorded for future viewing. This is not a mandatory training. Dates are June 29 at Noon CT and July 7 at 8 pm CT.

Leasing Animals

4-H Members that are going to lease animals, will need to complete a SD 4-H Animal Projects Lease Form. The link is: <https://extension.sdstate.edu/sites/default/files/2021-03/MC-02097.pdf>

All livestock lease forms must be turned into the 4-H Office by **June 1st**. **Exhibitors will upload lease agreements to 4HOnline for leased animals, deadline is June 1st by 11:59 pm CT.**

Breed Registration Papers

A copy of bred registration papers for registered and/or purebred animals must be uploaded in 4HOnline by **July 1 at 11:59 pm CT**. If a registration paper is not available by July 1, **an official letterhead with a detailed explanation from the breed association must be uploaded in its place**. Failure to upload a registration paper by July 1 will result in the animal being exhibited in the commercial/grade/crossbred division.

Exhibitors should have the original paper copy of the registration paper in hand during check in at State Fair.

Registration papers must show at least one of the following:

1. The member's name as owner
2. The name of the exhibitor and/or co-owner who is a member or the exhibitor's immediate family (parent or siblings/members of household)
3. The family ranch or farm name or parent's name
